Will attending a course affect my Social Welfare payment?

No. You can take part in our part-time Back to Education courses for up to 17 hours per week, without affecting your payments. You need to give the details of your course to your Social Welfare office and get their approval.

Where will the courses take place?

Courses will run in LCAES building in O'Connell Avenue and in a range of community locations across the City. Locations will be discussed with you when you are offered a place on a course. LCAES works closely with the Limerick City Community Education Network (LCEN), a network of geographical communities and communities of interest across Limerick City.
